Guidelines for the use of Leichhardt Rowing Club's Pontoon on Regatta Day

Leichhardt Rowing Club welcomes competing clubs to its club house and pontoon on regatta day. To assist smooth operations, we have developed the following guidelines which include directions from the Inner West Council. Good luck and have fun racing.... Unfortunately, LRC has no control over the weather of Iron Cove, don't blame us.

Could you also confirm your clubs intention to captain@lrc.com.au by the Friday of the regatta so that we have an idea of how many clubs are intending to boat from LRC/PLC Shed

1. The Council Gate will be open to trailers by 6.30am the day of the regatta
2. All clubs using pontoon to assist in clearing path of speed boats from 7am and straight after last race.
3. Trailers, boats and other equipment must not obstruct the walking and cycle pathways
4. Towing vehicles are not permitted to remain on Council property
5. No cars can be parked in Leichhardt Park at any time – fines will apply
6. Trailers are not allowed to be parked at the bottom of Glover St - fines apply
7. The side gate will be opened to allow pontoon access by 7am
8. All rowers are to follow the directives of the Pontoon Marshals
9. Oars are to be brought onto the pontoon just prior to departure
10. Place oars together in a set to one side of down ramp or along pontoon if not overloaded
11. Boats should only be brought down to the pontoon when whole crew is ready to depart
12. Visiting Clubs are not permitted to place their slings on the pontoon deck
13. No washing of non LRC boats on the pontoon at any time
14. Large boats are to primarily use the outside of the pontoon to depart and dock
15. Small boats are to primarily use the inside of the pontoon to depart and dock
16. Normal boat departure direction is to the East (opposite for DRC/BRC regattas)
17. Normal boat arrival direction is from the West (opposite for DRC/BRC regattas)
18. When arriving move the boat down as far as possible along the pontoon to allow following boats to dock
19. Place oars in set on one side of down ramp
20. Remove boat immediately
21. Remove oars back to your park area immediately
22. Keep off the pontoon when not directly involved
23. Additional Council Toilet facilities are located at the bottom of Glover St
24. Visiting tinnies are not to tie up on the bottom cleat next to the boating area. The bottom cleat is for loading and unloading only
25. Visiting Clubs are responsible to tidy up the area they use and place all rubbish in Council bins
26. All trailers are expected to have been removed from the park area within one hour of the final race
27. Any damage caused by the visiting club to Council or Leichhardt Rowing Club property is their responsibility
28. Leichhardt Rowing Club takes no responsibility for other club's equipment
